



The best places to visit in Paris

Paris is the capital of France and is located on the river Seine in the north of France. It has a population of over twelve million people. You can visit the Arc de Triomphe, which was built by Napoleon. From the Arc de Triomphe, you can walk down the Champs-Elysees and visit many stylish shops and restaurants. At the end of the Champs-Elysees you can go to the Place de la Concorde, which is the largest square in Paris.

Near the Place de la Concorde, there is the Louvre Museum. The Louvre was originally a palace in the 14th century, but now is one of the world's greatest art galleries and museums. There are more than thirty-five thousand works of art in the museum.

After you have been to the Louvre, you can visit the Eiffel Tower, which can be seen from all over Paris. You can go to the top of the Eiffel Tower and see great views of Paris. If you have enough time, you can also go to the Palace of Versailles, which is half an hour from Paris by train. Versailles was built in the 17th century and has beautiful rooms and gardens.
